LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS N^o 022 OF 2017

To: All Mariners, Owners, Agents and Charterers


Unmanned Vessel Operations 17th-28th May 2017

Mariners, Owners, Agents and Charterers are advised that an unmanned (remotely-controlled) vessel will be operating in the Inner Harbour area for training and trials between 17th and 28th May 2017.

The 7.2 metre length vessel, named 'CW74', will be operating mainly in Admiralty Waters in the southern part of the Inner Harbour between 08:30 and 17:30 hrs, however, it may occasionally go further north within the harbour to test the range of the telemetry.

The bright yellow vessel is fitted with navigation lights, day signals and an AIS transponder which will display its position whilst underway (a photograph of the CW74 is shown below in Annex 1), and will be piloted remotely from onboard the vessel SEVEN ANTARES alongside the QHM's Main Wharf.

All vessels operating in the Inner Harbour are requested to keep a sharp lookout for the CW74.
