Re: Unregistered port workers – Mooring service

Dear All

It has come to GPA's attention that mooring parties offering their services in the port are using unregistered workers to provide this service. Please note as from Monday, the mooring party members will be cross-checked against the list of registered workers provided by these companies. Any member of a mooring party not having the pertinent 'port worker' permit under that company will not be allowed to provide service. In case this results in insufficient members of the mooring party for any particular operation, the berthing manoeuvre will be cancelled. Operators are reminded that the a condition of their licence is;

"9) Persons employed by the applicant must be registered with the Employment and Training Board and fulfil all legal obligations in respect of pay, tax and social Insurance."

No exceptions will be made to this measure.
