

INSURANCE CONDITIONS FOR PORT OPERATOR LICENCE HOLDERS

All port operators must hold appropriate insurance cover for the activity for which they have been granted a port operator licence (both new and on renewal).

It will now be a condition of your port operator licence that you provide Third Party Liability/Public Liability/General Liability cover for any one accident or occurrence to cover each of your licensed operations within the Port Estate. The level of cover will be advised at the time of the licence application or confirmed at renewal.

Separate insurance cover will be required for vessels via the P&I Club.

Please note that insurance policies must be submitted in English.

The following conditions will also need to be included:.

1. The Gibraltar Port Authority and/or the Government of Gibraltar is named as an Additional Assured under the Public Liability and/or Third Party Liability and/or General Liability policy in respect of all operations and/or premises to which the licence applies.
2. Such policies shall include coverage for Death and/or Bodily Injury and/or Third Party Property Damage including Pollution, and also contain an endorsement confirming that your insurers agree to waive their rights of subrogation against the Gibraltar Port Authority and/or the Government of Gibraltar, and that any insurance carried by your organisation shall be considered primary and non contributory to any insurance carried by the Gibraltar Port Authority and/or the Government of Gibraltar.
3. To notify the Chief Executive of the Gibraltar Port Authority or any person authorised by the Gibraltar Port Authority in writing promptly of anything affecting the demised premises which could lead to a claim on the said insurance policy.
4. The Licensee shall be solely liable for payment of all insurance premiums and shall indemnify the Gibraltar Port Authority and/or the Government of Gibraltar in respect of any claim relating thereto.

The above is in addition to any other insurance obligations contained in your lease/licence.
